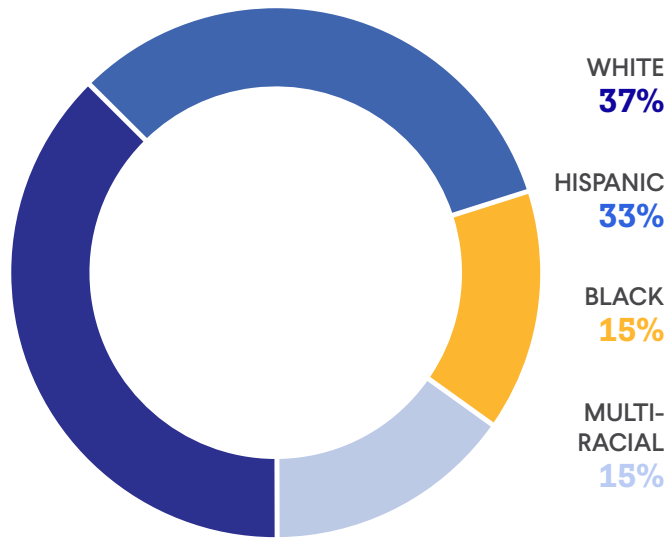

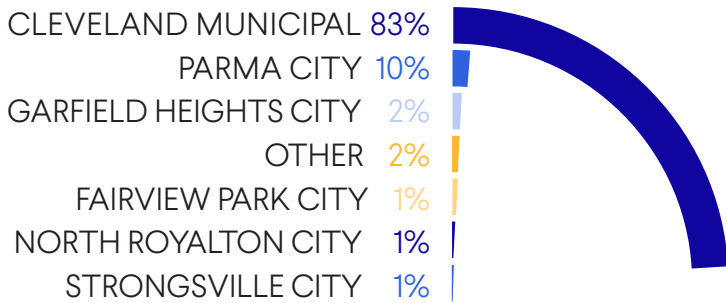

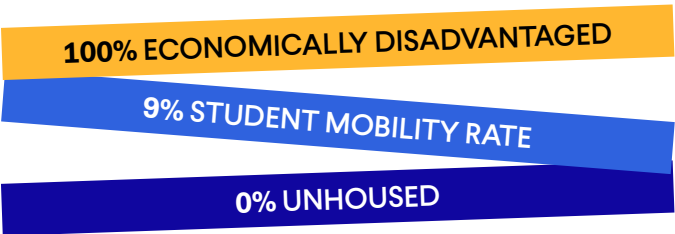
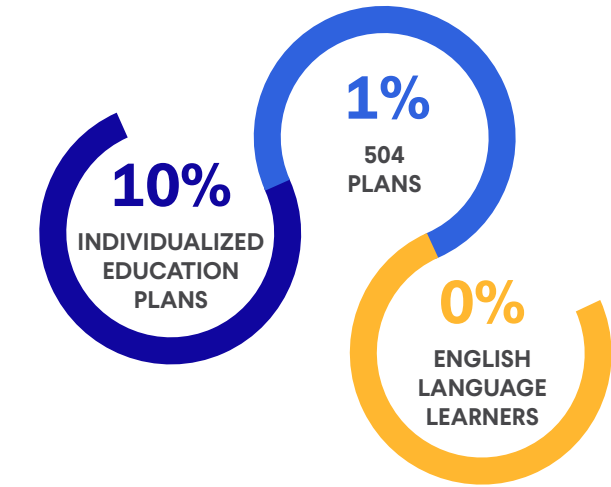
DISTRICTS OF RESIDENCE

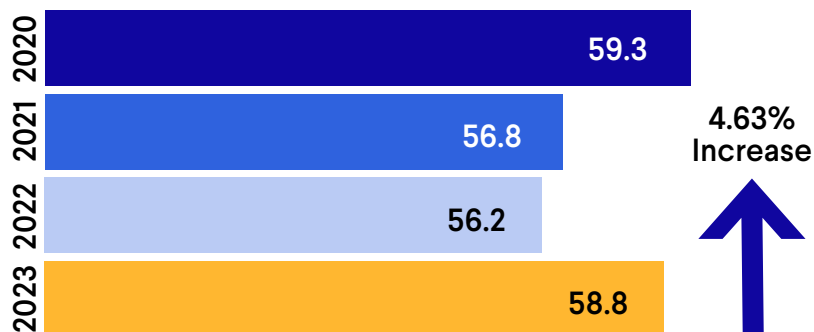
- Achieved a year-over-year performance increase

- Approved grade level expansion to include Early Kindergarten for the 2023-24 school year



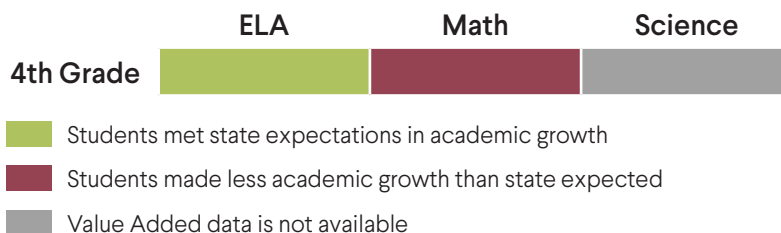
